

BIOETHICS MINOR

Requirements total 18 hours. This includes 12 hours of required courses and 6 hours of bioethics courses taken either at Trinity College or Trinity Graduate School. Students may also earn bioethics credit by enrolling in the institutes and/or wrap-around courses offered in connection with The Center for Bioethics & Human Dignity summer conference on Trinity's campus. Six of the required hours may meet general education requirements.

Students may meet all six elective requirements by taking all four of these courses: BE 474X, BE 475X, BE 476X and BE 477X.

² BE 474X (graduate course BE 5000), BE 475X (graduate course BE 7700), BE 477X (graduate course BE 5900), and BE 478 (graduate course BE 5200) have reduced in-course requirements for undergraduates. Courses taken under the graduate level designation remain at the graduate level in course content but are designated on the transcript as fulfilling the undergraduate requirements for a minor. If applied toward a minor and/or toward the required hours for graduation with the BA, the course(s) may not subsequently be applied toward a graduate degree.
